



Sailing Level One

Waterland, as a Royal Yachting Association training centre, provide tuition in sailing starting from the raw beginner to the more experienced. You are taught by qualified and experienced instructors that will get the best out of you and make your time with us enjoyable.

The appropriate start certificate is the level one course which is designated for adults or young people over sixteen years of age. The course teaches you rigging the boats which are an essential art especially when hiring boats at a later time for practice.

Tacking and gybeing, how to read the wind working as part of a crew and sailing a number of different boats are all encompassed in the Level one course which takes place over three one day sessions on the Sunday's mentioned.

On the successful completion of the course the candidate is presented with a logbook and certificate and then they can count on being on the way to becoming a sailor. The price of the course is set at £140.00 per person and all kit except footwear, lunch, swim equipment, and towel is provided.

Sailing Level Two

The level two course prepares you to contend with stronger winds and coping with capsizing of your craft, makes you more wind aware and equip's you with the theory information to make you a better sailor. The course is the appropriate qualification to hire boats in the stronger winds and as the course is over five week duration and you work constantly with our qualified instructors who will aim to get you up to the required standard to pass.

The cost of the course is £200.00 per person and all kit except footwear, lunch, swim equipment, and towel is provided.
